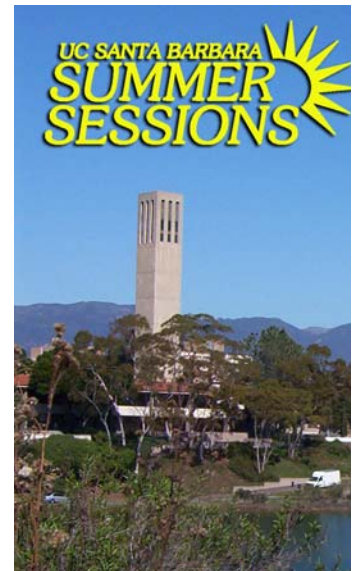


INTERNATIONAL TRANSFER STUDENTS –

with the Transitions Program

Make an early summer start at UCSB! Take summer courses and experience the many supportive ways that the NEW Summer Transitions International program helps you make a successful adjustment to your new campus. This valuable summer program offers newly-admitted International transfer students advanced preparation for the academic rigor of a research university, social activities where friendships with students and faculty can begin, and special summer-only courses that focus on giving you a comprehensive introduction to UCSB.



UCSB

The Summer Program Includes---

- *A pre-summer orientation workshop where you will be advised about immigration rules, transferring schools, academic expectations, and the courses to take in the summer. You will meet with current UCSB international students to learn about the challenges and rewards of transferring to UCSB.*
- *Reduced fees. International students pay the same as California residents during the summer.*
- *Credit-bearing Transitions courses. An upper-division writing course especially for International students: Writing Success at the Research University (Writing 125) will strengthen your facility in analyzing and writing sophisticated university-level essays. For all Transitions students: Motivation and Learning for Academic Success (Educ 117M) in which students learn about campus resources and strategies for succeeding at UCSB.*
- *Workshops to acquaint you with special topics such as ESL Listening skills for the Classroom, Study Skills for Transfers, Conventions of U.S. Academic Writing, and how to navigate the library.*
- *Transition and Support. Academic and personal support from student services such as The Office of International Students and Scholars, Campus Learning Assistance Services, and academic advisors in departments and the colleges.*
- *Numerous extracurricular activities including International Insight nights, a Welcome Lunch and Dinner just for Transitions students, a sailboat cruise, field trips to Santa Barbara events, hikes, and campus tours.*
- *Make friends. Begin the process by meeting new and current UCSB students when you go to the activities, attend courses, and participate in workshops.*
- *Meet student mentors trained to introduce you to the vibrant University community and help you discover the many joys of being a UCSB student.*
